

SOUTH CAROLINA STATE HOUSE

The history of South Carolina's State House is as colorful as the state itself. Begun in 1851, the original structure was dismantled due to defective materials. A new structure was begun in 1855 and suspended in 1865 as Sherman's Union Army swept through Columbia. Completed in 1907, the copper-domed granite building today wears six bronze stars to mark hits from Sherman's cannons. Admission is free and guided tours are available. Located at Main and Gervais Streets.



SOUTH CAROLINA STATE MUSEUM

The State Museum is a major attraction filled with fascinating exhibits which tell the story of South Carolina through art, history, natural history, and science/technology. Admission is charged. Located at 301 Gervais Street.

EDVENTURE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

The South's largest children's museum is the home of Eddie, the world's largest child, along with 300 hands-on exhibits to inspire children to experience the joy of learning. Admission is charged. Located at 211 Gervais Street.

RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

The Three Rivers Greenway is open for walking, running, and bicycling. The lighted and paved trails, boardwalks, and overlooks provide an opportunity to enjoy the tranquil beauty of the Congaree River.
